RESOLUTION NO. 2020-06

RESOLUTION AMENDING WATER RATES AND CHARGES FOR CUSTOMERS SERVED BY THE CORDRY-SWEETWATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT WATER UTILITY

WHEREAS, the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District is an Indiana Conservancy District organized and operated pursuant to I.C.14-33; and,

WHEREAS, the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District operates, as a part of its works of improvement and consistent with its District Plan, a water utility which provides potable water to retail customers within Hamblen Township, Brown County, Indiana; and,

WHEREAS, the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District purchases water at wholesale rates from the Town of Prince's Lakes for resale to Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District's Water Utility customers; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Prince's Lakes has adopted a rate increase for wholesale water and said increase is applicable to the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District Water Utility; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District has caused a rate study to be prepared. A copy of the rate study is on file at the District Office and available for public inspection. Based upon the information and recommendations contained in the rate study, it appears that in order to produce sufficient revenue to pay all of the legal and other necessary expenses incident to the operation of the water utility, that it is necessary that the rates and charges imposed upon the customers of the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District Water Utility must be increased.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District has determined, after considering the rate study and conducting a public hearing for which notice was given pursuant to law, that it is necessary in order to produce sufficient revenue to pay all of the legal and other necessary expenses incident to the operation of the water utility that rates must be increased.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District that:

1. The rates and charges to customers of the Cordry-Sweetwater Water Utility shall be increased as follows:
