MOTION: Mr. Benshoof moved to approve the April 21, 2015 CSCD Board Executive meeting minutes, seconded by Mr. Petersen. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION: Mrs. Wright moved to approve the April 21, 2015 CSCD Board meeting minutes, seconded by Mr. Benshoof. Motion carried unanimously.

10. Commission Reports:

A. Building:

- i. Mrs. Wright summarized her report.
- ii. Mr. Johann summarized the construction approval applications for which action was required by the Board.

MOTION: Mr. Benshoof moved to approve building applications 15-034, 15-023, 15-024, 15-030, 15-031, 15-032, 15-029, 15-025, 15-027, 15-028, 15-033, 15-036 contingent upon the lot owners obtaining all permits required by Brown County; seconded by Mr. Petersen - Motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Mr. Benshoof moved to approve building application 15-035 contingent upon the lot owners obtaining all permits required by Brown County; seconded by Mr. Petersen - Motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Mr. Benshoof moved to approve building application 15-037 contingent upon the lot owners reducing the proposed dock from extending 24' into the lake to 20' and obtaining all permits required by Brown County; seconded by Mr. Engle - Motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Mr. Engle moved to approve building application 15-038 contingent upon the lot owners reducing the current dock from extending 23' into the lake to 20' and obtaining all permits required by Brown County; seconded by Mr. Petersen - Motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Mrs. Wright moved to approve building application 15-026 contingent upon the lot owners reducing the proposed detached deck from 14' to 12' and obtaining all permits required by Brown County; seconded by Mr. Engle - Motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Following a statement by the applicant, and Board discussion Mr. Ray moved to deny the lot owner's request to continue work on a partially completed deck for which he had only recently submitted building application 15-039; seconded by Mr. Petersen - Motion passed unanimously.

iii. Mr. Johann indicated that precise water levels for both lakes have been determined by a surveyor, based on the elevations of the lakes' water discharge control structure. New water level gauges will be located on the beach side of the peninsula on Sweetwater Lake and on the CSCD boat dock on Cordry Lake.

MOTION: Mr. Petersen moved to approve extend the moratorium for new V-Drive watercraft to September 2015; seconded by Mr. Benshoof - motion passed unanimously.

11. Old Business:

i. As a result of the resignation of Cathey Byers from the Board of Directors of CSCD, effective May 15, 2015, a vacancy exists on the Board. A discussion occurred amongst the Board Members concerning whether the law requires a majority of the Board to be "resident" freeholders. Several Board Members expressed their opinion that the requirement that a majority of the board be resident freeholders only applied to the initial board and not to subsequent boards.

MOTION: Mr. Petersen moved that I.C.14-33-5-1(c)(1) be interpreted to apply only to the initial board of directors and that subsequent boards of directors need not be composed of a majority of resident freeholders. This interpretation is based upon the language contained in I.C.14-33-5-3(a)(3)(B), which provides "A nominee (for election to subsequent boards of directors) does not have to be a resident of the area of the district for which nominations are invited; seconded by Mr. Engle; there was discussion — motion passed with voting as follows:

Ray – No Benshoof – Yes Wright – No Petersen – Yes Engle – Yes

ii. Discussed the ongoing efforts to clarify the composition and responsibilities of the different Commissions.

12. New Business:

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i. Mr. Ray stated that Mrs. Byers had officially resigned on May 15, 2015. Two persons had shown interest in replacing her on the Board, both of whom were freeholders of Area 6 – David Moebs and Patrick Sherman. Based on the Board's determination of the IC 14-33 term "resident" was not applicable, both freeholders were deemed eligible for the vacant seat on the Board.

MOTION: Mr. Petersen moved to appoint Pat Sherman to fill the vacancy for Area 6 after Mrs. Byers resignation; seconded by Mr. Engle - motion passed, with voting as follows:

Ray – No
Benshoof – Yes
Wright – Abstained
Crimmins – Absent
Petersen – Yes
Engle – Yes

Mr. Sherman was sworn in by Mr. Young.

13. Board Members/Freeholder Concerns

i. Question whether Brown County Circuit Court judge be asked to resolve definition of "resident freeholder".
