Lot Owners who use wake enhancing options on their boats after signing a Ballast/Wave Enhancing Speed Boat Pre-Registration Certificate will lose their boating privileges after the first offense for one calendar year and will be banned from using the boat on the lakes after the second offense.

MOTION: Mr. Hetherington moved to approve stricter penalties for wake enhancing boats on the lakes; seconded by Mrs. Wright; there was discussion – motion passed unanimously.
