WHEREAS the Board of Directors have determined that it is necessary to limit the motor horsepower for pontoon boats to 100hp.

WHEREAS the Cordry Sweetwater conservancy District is an authority to make regulations for the administration of the affairs of the District, in accord to the Indiana Code Section 14, The Conservancy Act, the Board of Directors, in order to protect the Conservancy environment and the enjoyment of the property for each freeholder, proclaim that greater than 100 horsepower on a pontoon boat will not be permitted on the waters of the Conservancy.

BE IT RESOLVED A Pontoon boat shall be no longer than 28 feet long and if purchased after April 1, 2006 will have no greater than 100 horsepower motor. Decals will not be issued for a pontoon boat purchased before April 1, 2006, if:

1. The boat is sold or traded.
2. Ownership is transferred in any manner, including estate, will or operation of law
3. The craft becomes inoperable.
4. Lot owner fails to maintain a current decal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any violation of this rule shall forfeit boating privileges for one year from date of violation.
