

Lead & Copper Revised Rule (LCRR) & the CSCD

Background

The EPA is requiring all public water utilities to complete a lead service line inventory and submit it to state agencies by October 2024. This inventory will force utilities to investigate service line materials from the water main all the way to the foundation of the dwelling it serves.

Fact

All CSCD-owned service lines (from the main to the meter) are PLASTIC. The District will be focusing all efforts on identifying the customer-owned service lines (from the meter to the foundation of your home).
