RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 3 Amended

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2024-3, RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CLASS ONE POWER OR SPEED BOAT MAXIMUM WEIGHT AND OPERATING RESTRICTIONS, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2015-10, AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2004-03

WHEREAS, the Cordry Sweetwater Conservancy District ("CSCD") is an Indiana Conservancy District organized and operating pursuant to I.C. 14-33; and,

WHEREAS, the affairs of CSCD are managed by a Board of Directors authorized by I.C. 14-33-5-20 to exercise general supervision of and make regulations for the administration of the affairs of CSCD; and,

WHEREAS, CSCD owns and maintains Cordry and Sweetwater Lakes as a part of CSCD's works of improvement; and,

WHEREAS, CSCD permits freeholders of CSCD to utilize Cordry and Sweetwater Lakes for recreational purposes and to operate watercraft thereon, subject to CSCD's Rules and Regulations; and,

WHEREAS, it appears to the CSCD Board of Directors that wakes given off by boats utilizing Cordry and Sweetwater Lakes can cause damage to the lakes and shorelines, disrupt the ecology of the lakes, and create a safety hazard for individuals utilizing the lakes and shorelines adjacent thereto; and,

WHEREAS, in order to protect the ecology of the lakes and to provide for the safety of individuals utilizing the lakes and shorelines adjacent thereto, restrictions should be imposed upon the weight of watercraft utilizing the lakes and, further, restrictions should be imposed upon the utilization of wake enhancing devices by operators of watercraft utilizing the lakes.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of CSCD that:

1. Class One power or speed boats shall not exceed 4,000 pounds dry weight. The weight of the boat is presumptively established by reference to the JD Powers Boat Database at www.nadaguides.com/boats or the weight of the boat as stated by the manufacturer's specifications. If the weight stated in the JD Powers Boat Database differs from the weight stated in the manufacturer's specifications, the lesser weight shall be considered the true dry weight of the boat. Any disputes concerning the weight of a boat must first be heard by the CSCD Security Commission, and ultimately resolved by the CSCD Board of Directors. The 4,000 lbs. dry weight limitation does not apply to watercraft purchased and registered prior to November 17, 2015, if the watercraft has been continuously registered to the same owner.

- 2. Resolution No. 2024-3 shall remain in full force and effect except as specifically amended herein.
 - 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after March 19, 2024.
